Districting Process

Step	Description
Two Initial Hearings August 20 & September 3, 2025	Held prior to release of draft maps. Education and to solicit input on the composition of districts.
Release draft maps September 10, 2025	Maps must be posted at least 7 days prior to 3 rd hearing.
Two hearings on draft maps September 17 & October 1, 2025	Two meetings to discuss and revise the draft maps and to discuss the election sequence.
Release revised maps September 24, 2025	Maps must be posted at least 7 days prior to 4 th hearing.
Map adoption October 1, 2025	Map adopted via resolution. Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption.
County Committee Hearing Late 2025 or early 2026	The Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization must hold a hearing within the district for final approval of the change to by-Trustee Area elections
First Elections November 2026 & 2028	The Los Angeles County Committee on School District Organization must hold a hearing within the district for final approval of the change to by-Trustee Area elections

Districting Rules and Goals

1. Federal Laws

Equal Population
Federal Voting Rights Act
No Racial Gerrymandering



2. California Criteria

In prioritized order:

1. **Geographically contiguous**
2. **Avoid division of neighborhoods and “communities of interest”**
(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)
3. **Avoid division of Cities and Census Designated Places**
4. **Easily identifiable boundaries**
5. **Compact**
(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

2. California Prohibition

“Shall not adopt election district boundaries for the purpose of favoring or discriminating against an incumbent, political candidate, or political party.”










Map 107

Split northern area






Map 101






